As in past years, we have invited speakers from the DOL, IRS, CMS, PBGC and Treasury to discuss their regulatory priorities and expectations for the coming year to the extent possible given the change in Administration.

This year's preliminary agenda has the following highlights:

- The current funded status of the PBGC, the latest deficit projections and estimated insolvency and
- A discussion of the PBGC's recent Request for Information regarding Alternative Methods for Computing Withdrawal Liability; Settlement of Withdrawal and Mass Withdrawal Liability
- Suggestions for redefining the existing "guaranty" program
- A status report on outstanding rescue applications filed under the MPRA
- A "case study" on the only successful MPRA rescue application filed to date.
- An update on efforts to enact proposed legislation to authorize the creation of Composite plans
- Implications of "repeal and replace" proposals re: the Affordable Care Act (ACA)
- A discussion of the benefit implications of tax reform proposals in the 115th Congress
- The current status of the "conflict of interest" (DOL amended fiduciary) rules
- The need to revisit the question of "phased retirement" regulations post-PPA and MPRA
