EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MICHAEL SCOTT'S REMARKS TO 2018 NCCMP ANNUAL CONFERENCE

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: ON MONDAY, NCCMP EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MICHAEL SCOTT ADDRESSED THE 2018 NCCMP ANNUAL CONFERENCE ON CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS FOR THE MULTIEMPLOYER SYSTEM. MICHAEL DISCUSSED THE WORK OF THE JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE ON SOLVENCY OF MULTIEMPLOYER PENSION PLANS, AS WELL AS NCCMP'S EFFORTS TO EDUCATE THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE AND THEIR STAFF ON THE FAR-REACHING ECONOMIC IMPACT, UNIQUE NATURE OF MULTIEMPLOYER PENSION PLANS, AND THE DRAMATIC CONSEQUENCES OF INACTION. HE ALSO DISCUSSED THE NCCMP'S WORK TO DEVELOP REAL SOLUTIONS TO THE CHALLENGES FACING THE MULTIEMPLOYER SYSTEM THAT CAN GAIN THE BIPARTISAN SUPPORT NEEDED TO PASS CONGRESS AND THAT MAXIMIZE THE LIKELIHOOD OF IMPLEMENTATION BY THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH.
