



TOPIC: NCCMP OP-ED CALLING FOR REPEAL OF “CADILLAC TAX”

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: NCCMP IS PLEASED TO REPORT THAT ON FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 13 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MICHAEL SCOTT PUBLISHED AN OP-ED IN REAL CLEAR POLICY URGING THE SENATE TO REPEAL THE “CADILLAC TAX.” THE OP-ED NOTES THAT IN JULY, THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OVERWHELMINGLY VOTED 419-6 TO REPEAL THE HEALTH CARE “CADILLAC TAX.” AS THE SENATE RETURNS TO WORK, NCCMP’S OP-ED CALLS FOR THE BIPARTISAN GROUP OF MORE THAN 60 SENATORS TO REPEAL THE CADILLAC TAX AND END THE THREAT THAT WILL DESTROY THE HEALTH CARE OF 181 MILLION HARD-WORKING AMERICANS AND THEIR FAMILIES.
