



TOPIC: MICHAEL SCOTT'S REMARKS TO 2019 NCCMP ANNUAL CONFERENCE

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: ON SEPTEMBER 23, NCCMP EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MICHAEL SCOTT ADDRESSED THE NCCMP 2019 ANNUAL CONFERENCE. MR. SCOTT REVIEWED THE URGENT NEED FOR BIPARTISAN MULTIEMPLOYER PENSION REFORM LEGISLATION IN 2019 AND NOTED THAT IN 2019 CONGRESS HAS BEEN MORE AWARE OF THE URGENCY OF THE CRISIS IN MULTIEMPLOYER PENSIONS, MORE COMMITTED TO ACT, AND HAS BEEN SEEKING INPUT FROM THE MULTIEMPLOYER COMMUNITY. HE REPORTED THAT NCCMP'S BOARD HAS ADOPTED COMMON SENSE PRINCIPLES FOR MULTIEMPLOYER PENSION REFORM THAT PROVIDE A FRAMEWORK FOR A COMPREHENSIVE SOLUTION. MR. SCOTT ENCOURAGED PLANS, UNIONS, EMPLOYERS, PARTICIPANTS, AND PLAN PROFESSIONALS TO REACH OUT TO SENATE AND HOUSE LEADERSHIP AND MEMBERS TO DRIVE HOME THE IMPORTANCE OF BIPARTISAN REFORM LEGISLATION THIS YEAR.
