





Development of real collectively agreed wages in selected EU countries




Real development adjusted for inflation on the basis of the Harmonized Index of Consumer Prices (HICP). Some data still provisional.

Collective Bargaining in the European Union



Construction output prices still rising sharply...




- Construction services prices are still rising significantly faster than the general price level at the moment
- reasons: initially (2021) mainly shortage of materials, then generally sharp rise in raw material prices, then mainly sharp rise in energy prices

...however, there are sings of easing

Raw material prices (HWWI-Indizes*, 2020=100)




 Raw material prices down significantly since spring last year, energy prices down significantly since fall last year

Residential construction: lending slumed



Housing loans (in Eur billion)

- Lending for residential construction at the lowest level since the year 2010
- Interplay of: High inflation, sharply rising construction prices, higher interest rates and more restrictive lending



Outlook: weak construction activity continues

Building permits (costs in billions of euros)



- building permits have fallen significantly in residential construction: lowest level since the beginning of 2020
- Non-residential construction at least able to maintain permit levels, but only in nominal terms (with costs rising significantly))
