WASHINGTON, DC – July 11, 2024 – Today, the National Coordinating Committee for Multiemployer Plans (NCCMP) issued the following statement from Executive Director Michael Scott:

"NCCMP strongly supports the nomination of Deva Kyle to be the 17th Director of the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation (PBGC). Deva's extensive experience at the PBGC as well as in the private sector representing defined-benefit plans will allow her to provide the PBGC with the leadership the nation needs to protect the retirement security of millions of Americans whose pensions are insured by the PBGC's single-employer and multiemployer guaranty programs. NCCMP was particularly grateful to Deva for the expertise she provided while on detail to the House Ways & Means Committee during the Joint Select Committee on Solvency of Multiemployer Plans.
